Special ordering conditions Light and power connection

1. Miscellaneous

- The rental price is for the duration of the event, plus the statutory VAT.
- A counter is always set for power connections. Rental price EUR 75,00.
- The acceptance of the service must be specified precisely by the exhibitor; it will be charged by the Augsburg Exhibition Centre. If it turns out later that a value that was too low was given, the differences are shown with a Surcharge calculated retroactively according to expenditure.
- The electricity consumption price amounts to EUR 0.40 per kWh.
- The activation of the power supply takes place only after payment of the connection.
- The invoice must be checked immediately. Complaints about the scope of the invoiced deliveries and services are to be made immediately.

2. Use this form to order a power supply.

The order and the stand sketch must be submitted to Messe Augsburg ASMV GmbH, Project Management by the order deadline. No guarantee can be given that installations applied for after this deadline will be carried out on time.

3. If an exhibitor withdraws, the booked services will be invoiced in full unless he has cancelled the services in writing at least 14 days before the start of the event with the project management of Messe Augsburg.

4. The connection of non-registered equipment, in particular hotplates and stoves, shall entitle the exhibitor to immediately block the connection in order to ensure that all exhibitors receive an even supply of electricity. Special connections are required for electrical systems which cannot be supplied from the basic network due to their high connected load.

5. Systems, equipment and stand installations must comply with the regulations of the VDE and the local power supply company. The responsibility for the electrical system lies with the exhibitor. Connected loads above 3 kW are designed exclusively as four-wire connections for load-related reasons.

The type of protection used is the residual current protective circuit (tripping current 30 mA). For this reason, the company's own distribution boards must be equipped with separate neutral conductor rails. Messe Augsburg accepts no liability for damage caused by defective power lines and equipment to which neither it nor the Stadtwerke Augsburg owns ownership rights.

6. The exhibitor is obliged to switch off his electricity daily before leaving his stand (liability for damages in the event of failure to do so). If equipment has to remain in operation overnight (cooling equipment, etc.), the exhibitor must ensure that no damage can occur.

7. The use of immersion heaters and double sockets is prohibited for safety reasons.

8. supply lines, switchboards, meters, etc. provided by Messe Augsburg on a rental basis shall remain the property of Messe Augsburg or the property of Stadtwerke Augsburg. The exhibitor must ensure that the material used is available again for dismantling at the end of the event, complete and undamaged, or that it is returned. Missing parts will be charged to the exhibitor at the replacement price. is calculated.

9. connections from the existing ring line to the stand may only be made by Messe Augsburg or the Stadtwerke Augsburg commissioned by it.

10. The unauthorised connection of cables and equipment to existing cables of another stand by the exhibitor is not permitted and entitles Messe Augsburg to disconnect the connection immediately.

11. In the event of an interruption or irregularity in the electricity supply, as well as in the event of a malfunction in the main network connection of the exhibition site, Messe Augsburg shall be released from its obligation to provide services. The same shall apply if circumstances on the exhibition site (e.g. a short circuit) result in an interruption of the power supply without Messe Augsburg or Stadtwerke Augsburg being responsible for this.

12. the exhibitor shall bear the costs of rectifying faults caused by the exhibitor or by third parties commissioned by the exhibitor.

13. The liability of the parties and their vicarious agents for culpably caused damage is excluded, unless the damage was caused by intent or gross negligence; this does not apply to damage resulting from injury to life, limb or health or the violation of essential contractual obligations, i.e. such obligations the fulfilment of which is essential for the proper execution of the contract and the observance of which the contractual partner may regularly rely on (so-called cardinal obligations). In the event of a breach of material contractual obligations which are not based on intent or gross negligence, liability shall be limited to the damage which the liable party foresaw as a possible consequence of the breach of contract at the time of conclusion of the contract or which the liable party has suffered in consideration of the Circumstances she knew or should have known should have foreseen. The provisions of the Product Liability Act shall remain unaffected.

14. All regulations and conditions specified on this form shall take precedence over the General Conditions of Participation of Messe Augsburg ASMV GmbH and the Special Conditions of Participation of AUGSBOW 2021 with regard to the services ordered here.
